



- Roost availability








6 When to survey

Most importantly: At night!

More specifically, half an hour before sunset until half an hour after sunrise for maximum coverage with statics.









Where to survey bats

- Potential roost sites (Do not disturb!)
- Potential foraging sites
- Anywhere you want!
